COURSE OVERVIEW

Your students can begin their career in healthcare with this entry-level course. This qualification will give them the foundation skills necessary to work in an assistant role in a health, aged or residential care setting, or to undertake further study in the field.

Australia's healthcare industry is a strong-growth sector with more than 50,000 jobs expected to open in the next five years.

Health Workforce Strategy for Queensland to 2032, states that "over the next 10 years, Queensland will need up to 45,000 additional staff working in the health system" alone.

This course will equip your students to work with people from diverse backgrounds, recognise healthy body systems, work safely in the health industry, maintain medical stock, learn to interpret and apply medical terminology, hygienic food practices, basic infection control prevention practices, clean and maintain beds and rooms in a health setting. Our highly-experienced industry professionals will guide your students every step of the way to ensure their transition into the health sector is a success.

Successful completion of this course may lead to our graduate's gaining employment in an assistance role in a health care facility as a ward assistant, orderly, food services assistant or laundry services worker once they leave high school. It will also give the graduate the foundation skills they will need to undertake further study in the industry, or to continue towards further tertiary studies after high school.

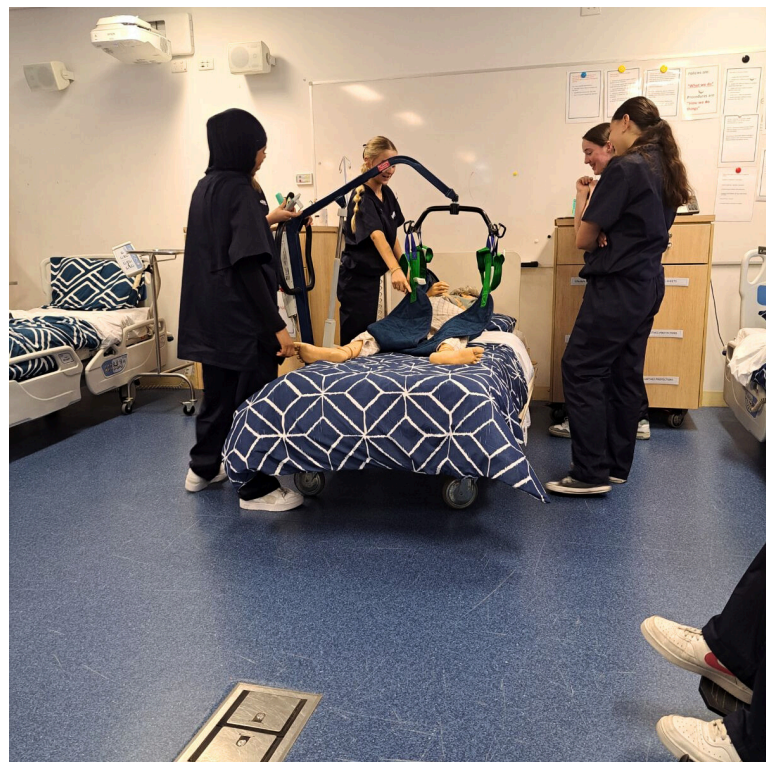

While students will enrol into the nationally recognised qualification, HLT23221 Certificate II in Health Support Services, The Axiom College Health Hub program can provide students with so much more.

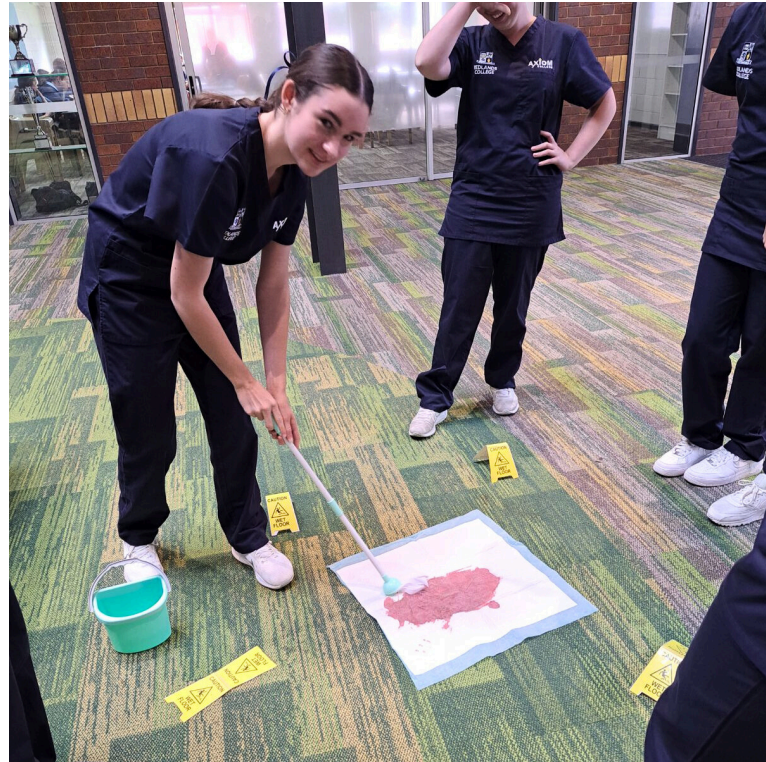
Our Health Hub Program also provides the following for students to learn about:

- healthy body systems, and identify parts of the brain
- how to read blood pressure monitors
- how to read blood oxygen meters and determine health readings
- How to take patients body temperature
- Safely move patients using body slings, wheel chairs, shower chairs, etc.
- Learn the correct way to handle medical waste
- Learn how to use medical forms, technical terms and jargon
- How to write up progress notes, incidents reports and hazard reports
- Patient feeding using the specialised utensils
- Learning how to deal with bodily fluids and potentially infectious waste
- Clean and make up hospital beds and rooms to hospital standards
- Patient dressing technique including clothes protectors and incontinence pads
- Donning and doffing compression stockings to avoid leg clots
- Patient showering utilising shower chairs
- Identify and use the correct PPE for various situation

COMMITMENT TO OUR HEALTH HUB PROGRAM

As our Health Hub program is more than a simple VETiS funded accredited course, there are minimum set of condition that come with this program that the school must agree to and be prepared to commit to a 2-year MOU.

The reason for this is due to the time and cost associated with setting up a Health Hub, we feel it is fair that both School and RTO forge a partnership, stating with a formal agreement (MOU)

Set up process

1. Discuss possible classroom location within the school or is it viable to send students to one of Axiom Colleges campuses
2. If delivery site is available at school, discuss the need to have this room set up permanently for the Health Hub program due to the size and the amount of equipment that is required
3. Discuss how this equipment will be obtained.
 - a. Axiom College purchases the equipment and the equipment will remain the property of Axiom College
 - b. The school wishes to own their own equipment and Axiom College provide the list of equipment. Refer to the Health Hub Set Up Checklist further in this brochure.
 - c. The school wishes Axiom College to buy the equipment on behalf of the school, Axiom College will invoice the school total cost once all equipment has been sourced. Equipment remains the property of the school.
4. Discuss the deliver days. These are generally one (1) day per week for 15 to 20 weeks. However, this can be negotiated to suit school need within reason.
5. Create an MOU for a minimum of 2 years

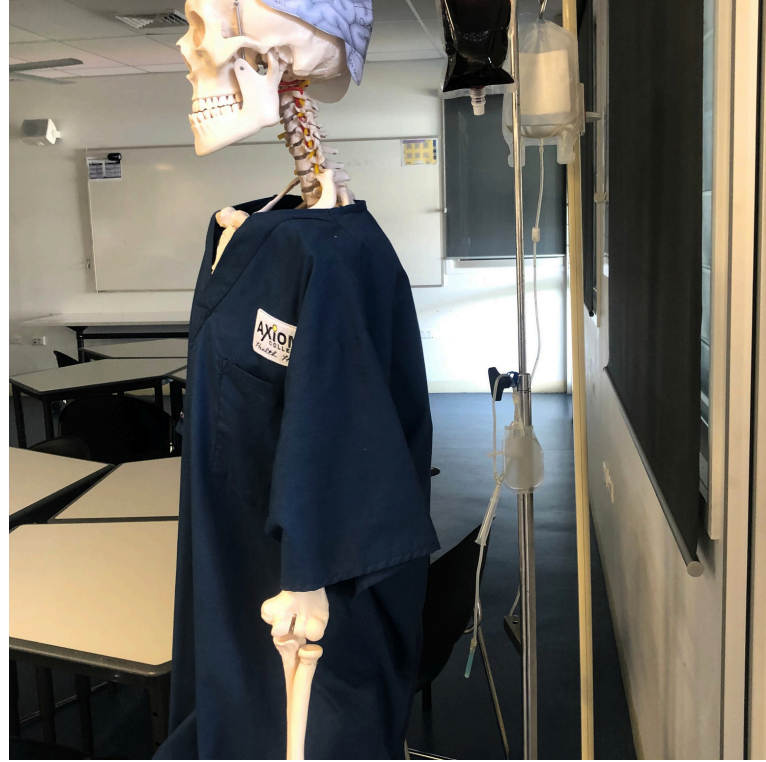

POST-GRADUATION PATHWAY

Once our students graduate the Health Hub program (HLT23221), they may wish to enroll into our HLT33115 Certificate III in Health Services Assistance course for further study within the industry. Students may be able to accelerate this program by using some course credits from units of competency completed as part of the Health Hub program.

This program extends the graduate learning and can assist them onto the path of employment within the health industry or assist them with entry into higher education. This is a fee for service program. Cost will vary depending on the individual student as a result on whether they can obtain course credits for previous studies.
